Selwyn High Schools' Waste Art Competition

Instructions 2022

Eligibility	The competition is open to any individual or pair (not group entries) of artists who is High School or Intermediate (Year 7-13) age attending school in Selwyn or home schooling in the Selwyn District.
Requirements	Art pieces must be produced using waste materials from either domestic or industrial sources re purposed into Artwork; examples can be reused textile materials, metal, paper, plastic, in fact anything that was due for disposal.
	The work must be that of an individual artist or duo who will sign to the effect that it is their work alone .
	Artists will be welcome to briefly explain their pieces to the judges if they wish, including the concepts and the materials used.
	The art can be wearable, sculpture, or a hanging piece.
	Three dimensional pieces must be such that they can easily be transported and displayed in an indoor setting such as the judging hall or library entrances.
	Artists are expected to take due consideration of any hazards relating to their work. For instance, processes such as welding must only be undertaken by those with knowledge and experience.
	Artists must give permission for their work to be displayed in any location deemed suitable by the organisers and judges, following the close of the competition. All pieces will be returned to the artists after any period of such display.
Judging	Lincoln Envirotown will invite a panel of judges outside of their organization to undertake this task. This will be carried out after all eligible pieces have been set up on display; currently we expect judging to be carried out at the end of the first morning of the public display.
Dates & Venue	Provisionally these are as follows: Entry forms must be submitted by 5pm, Monday 1 August

	Friday 12 th August from 3-7pm Students set up their Art pieces at the venue.
	Saturday 13 th August 10am-1pm Public Viewing.
	Saturday 13 th August 11am -12.15pm Judges circulate and talk to Artists where applicable, followed by judges meeting.
	Saturday 13 th August 1pm Awards are announced, and presentations made.
	Saturday 13 th – Sunday 14 th August 4.00pm Art work left on display in Te Ara Ātea.
